



Terms and Conditions – April 2006

1 – Mixing Business Ltd (hereafter called Mixing Business) and Mixing Pleasure which is a sub brand of Mixing Business will provide networking events for people to attend. The aim of each event is to create an environment where like minded individuals can meet and explore new business opportunities with each other. Mixing Business and Mixing Pleasure in no way guarantee that any new business will occur as a result of attending one of our events.

2 – Mixing Business and Mixing Pleasure Logos and material are protected by copyright and trade mark registration and can only be used by members of Mixing business and Mixing Pleasure with the prior permission in writing of the Directors of Mixing Business and Mixing Pleasure

Membership

3 – Membership of Mixing Business is for a minimum period of 12 months and commences on completion of the membership fees payable

4 – Members that Join Mixing Business instantly become Members of Mixing Pleasure.

5 – Mixing Business Membership fees are payable by one annual payment in advance.

Share Issue

6 – Shares will be issued in Mixing Business at a Price of £1.00 each.

Membership Costs

7 – Individuals will pay £ 200 Plus VAT for Membership of Mixing Business Plus £ 100 for 100 shares in Mixing Business. Therefore Minimum cost would be £ 300 Plus VAT

8 – Corporates will pay £ 300 Plus VAT for Membership of Mixing Business with No Share Option.

Cancellation of Membership

9 – Members can cancel their Membership of Mixing Business after 12 months by giving one month's written notice.



Right To Cancel

9a – Each Member shall have 7 days from the time of application to cancel their membership subscription. Shares purchased are non refundable.

Discounts

10 – Such discounts as may be available from time to time are applicable to the first years Membership only, after which time the full Membership fees apply.

Dining Fees

11 - Fees for Food and events are separate to Membership Fees and are payable in advance. The Price may vary from event to event, but will usually be in the region of £ 20 Plus VAT.

Excluded Disciplines

12 – Those involved in Multi Level Marketing where attendance is to recruit other Members to the associated Business Opportunity.

Exclusivity of Disciplines

13 – There is **no** exclusivity of disciplines. Within the guidelines as described above all disciplines are welcome to join Mixing Business.

Additional Members in the Same Organisation

14 – The following sliding scale of Membership Fees for additional Members from the same Organisation will apply. There will be a Maximum number of 5 Members from the same Organisation allowed.

- 1st Member – £ 300 Plus VAT
- 2nd Member – 10 % Discount off £ 300
- 3rd Member – 20 % Discount off £ 300
- 4th Member – 30 % Discount off £ 300
- 5th Member – Max 40 % Discount off £ 300

Event Bookings

15 – Members will be reminded by E mail and by the Website of Forthcoming events and invited to confirm their attendance. When numbers are limited, there will be a 1st-come-1st-served system put in place.

Attendance by Guests

16 – Guests are welcome to attend twice before deciding if they would like to join Mixing Business.



Colleagues from the Same Company

17 – A maximum number of 2 members from the same Company may attend any event at the same time.

Right to Suspend

18 – Mixing Business and Mixing Pleasure have the right to Suspend any Member who they believe has acted in a manner that brings Mixing Business or Mixing Pleasure into disrepute. In this case Membership fees are non refundable.

19 – Any decision to reinstate a Member is solely at the discretion of the Directors of Mixing Business.
